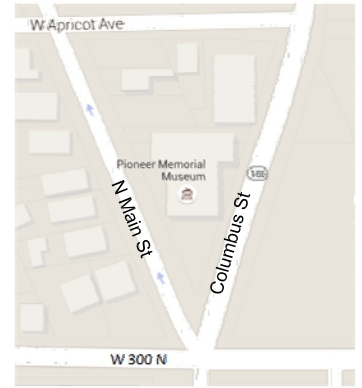

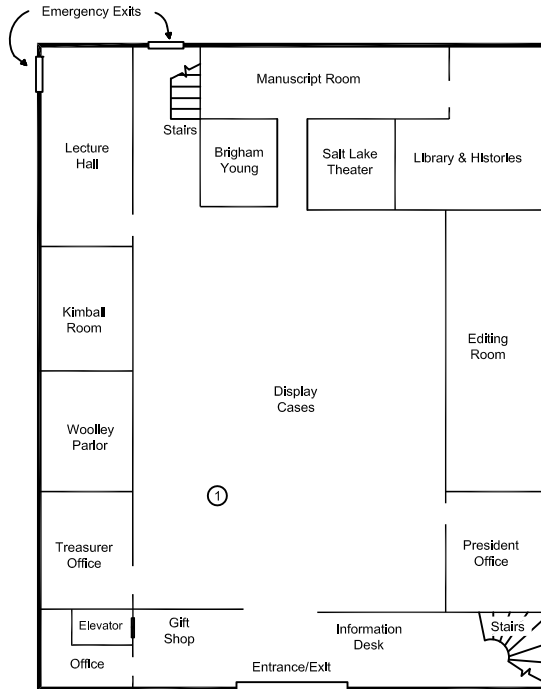

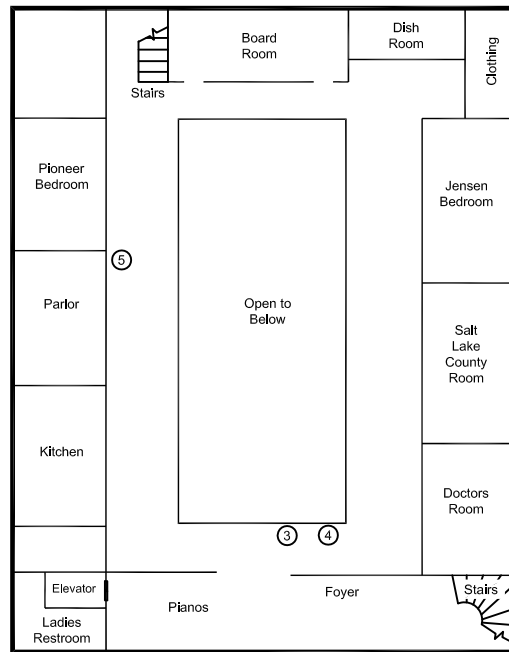


VICINITY MAP

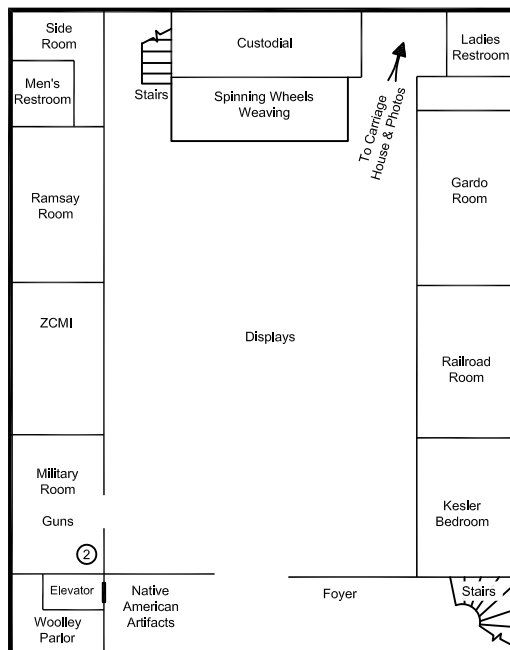
MUSEUM FLOOR PLANS



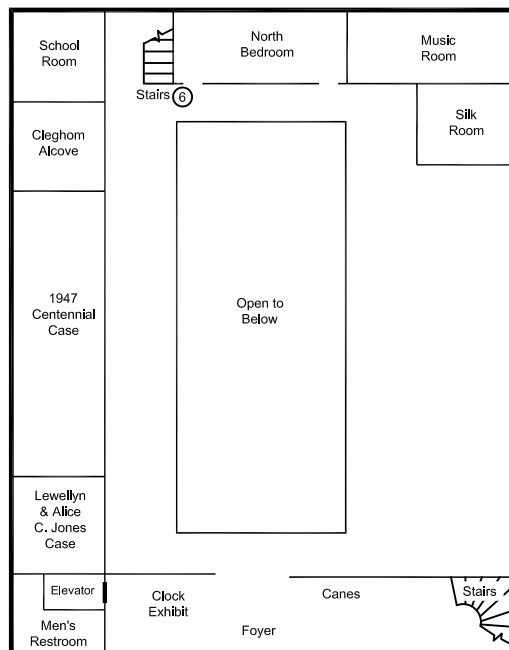
FIRST FLOOR

BASEMENT



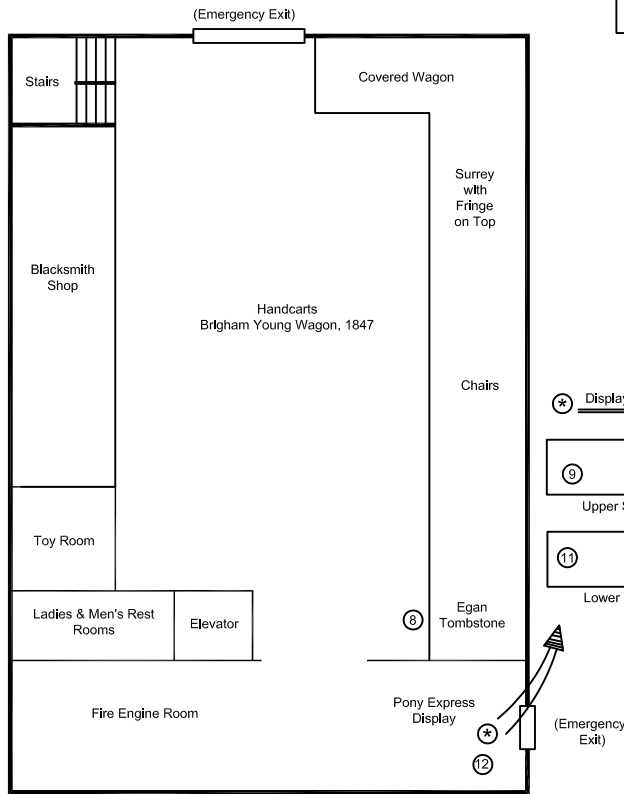

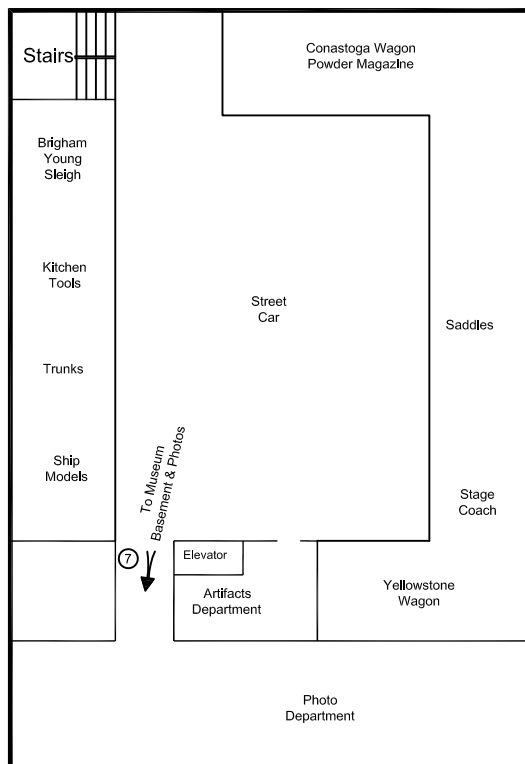
